Chickens	Two legs, sharp beaks, feathers, gizzards, red wattle under chin, red combs on heads, roosters have spurs on back of legs, hens are females, roosters are males,	Animal	Small pebbles called grit to grind food in gizzards, extra calcium to make eggs strong, cereal, fish meal, seeds, and grit, water,	Eggs, meat	Hen's body keeps the eggs warm and slightly damp,
sheep	Four legs, covered in fleece, gets sheared once per year, live in groups called flocks, tear at grass because their teeth are not sharp to bit, male is a ram, female is an ewe,	Animal	Water,	wool	Live outside most of the year, but need protecting from wolves and foxes, grows two teeth each year for four years,
Onion plant	Bulb plant, bulb lays dormant during cold time and when water is lacking,	Plant	Sunlight, water, air	onions
